

PEACE SCRIPTURES

Ps 94:19 In the multitude of my anxious thoughts within me, Your comforts cheer and delight my soul!

Lev 6:6 I will give you peace in the land; you shall lie down and none shall fill you with dread or make you afraid; and I will clear the ferocious beasts out of the land, and no sword shall go through your land.

Num 6:26 The Lord will lift up His approving countenance upon me and give me peace (tranquility of heart and life) continually.

Ps 4:8 In peace I will both lie down and sleep, for You, Lord, alone make me to dwell in safety and confident trust.

Ps 85:8 I will listen with expectancy to what God the Lord will say, for he will speak peace to me because I am in right standing with Him – I will not turn away to self confident folly.

PS 119:165 I have great peace because I love Your law; nothing shall offend me or make me stumble.

PS 122:7 Peace is within my walls and prosperity is within my palace.

Is 26:3 You will guard me and keep me in perfect and constant peace because my mind, both its inclination and its character is stayed on You, because I commit myself to You, I lean on You, and I hope confidently in You.

John 14:27 Peace I leave with you; My own peace I now give and bequeath to you. Not as the world gives do I have to you.. I will not let my heart be troubled, neither will I be afraid. I will stop allowing myself to be agitated and disturbed. I will not permit myself to be fearful and intimidated and cowardly and unsettled.

John 16:33 I have told you these things, so that in Me you may have perfect peace and confidence. In the world you may have tribulation and trials and distress and frustration; but be of good cheer, take courage, be confident, certain, undaunted! For I have overcome the world. I have deprive it of its power to harm you and I have conquered it for you.

Rom 5:1 Therefore, since we are justified (acquitted, declared righteous, and given a right standing with God) through faith, let us grasp the fact that we have the peace of reconciliation to hold and to enjoy peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ the Messiah, the Anointed One.

Eph 2:14 For He is Himself our Peace, our bond of unity and harmony.

Phil 4:6-7 Do not fret or have any anxiety about anything, but in every circumstance and in everything by prayer and petition (definite requests), with thanksgiving, continue to make your wants known to God. And God's peace shall be yours, that tranquil state of a soul assured of its salvation through Christ, and so fearing nothing from God and being content with its earthly sort that is, that peace, which transcends all understanding shall garrison and mount guard over your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.

2 Pet 1:2 May grace (God's favor) and peace (which is perfect well being, all necessary good, all spiritual prosperity, and freedom from fears and agitating passions and moral conflicts, be multiplied to you in the full, personal, precise, and correct knowledge of God and Jesus Christ our Lord.
